## Ironmen Standing Rules (02/03/2022)

- 1. Thursday shall be designated as Play Day with a shotgun start. For two to nine players on Play Day, normal points will be awarded for attendance, for each birdie, and for each Hole in One for Ironmen Champion standings. A regular <u>sweeps</u> play day requires ten or more players.
- 2. All members must check in fifteen minutes prior to starting time on play days.
- 3. All scorecards must be signed, verified, and turned in to the scorer immediately after play. Scorecards not meeting the criteria will be disqualified from the Sweeps.
- 4. For each player group, one member will volunteer to be the scorekeeper. The scorekeeper shall be responsible to meet Rule 3 requirements.
- 5. On Play Days when greens are sanded and not swept, a maximum 2 putt rule may be in effect, as determined by the starter.
- 6. A member must have a recorded handicap in order to be eligible to compete for sweeps awards and participate in tournaments.
- 7. To qualify for an Ironmen handicap, a player must have 3 scores on the Par 3 course accompanied by a member of The Ironmen. The games may be played on a regular Play Day, or on any other day by notifying the Play Day Chairman.
- 8. Annual Ironmen Champion shall be awarded at the General Membership meeting in October in accordance with the Practices and Procedures, Section 7.
- 9. The current year's Officers shall be responsible for drawing up a budget at the end of each fiscal year for approval by the Membership at the October General Membership Meeting for the next year's Ironmen expenditures.
- 10. Items of \$25.00 or less, which are not defined in the budget, may be paid at the discretion of the President.
- 11. The Villager is the official medium of communication of The Ironmen.
- 12. The Standing Rules may be changed in accordance with the By-Laws Article XII Section 3.
- 13. The Ironmen will award a member playing on the regular play day game a trophy and \$25.00 (twenty five) dollars in cash for a hole in one. Total cost of the cash award and trophy not to exceed \$60.00 (Sixty) dollars.
- 14. The Ironmen will give an Honorarium in honor of a deceased Member. The donation amount shall be established annually as part of the budget process.
- 15. The following items shall be posted in the Club Posting Room behind the pro shop: The By-Laws, the Standing Rules, Practices and Procedures, Sweeps Results, a copy of the golf etiquette and golf's golden rules.
- 16. A maximum of eight (8) strokes will be scored on any hole for any player for all Ironmen play.
