**Secretary's Report**: Bill Travis summarized the OctoberFebruary 3rd, 2022 Winter Meeting minutes that had been previously forwarded to the club membership. A motion was made and seconded to approve the mines, and it passed unanimously.

After further discussion, a motion was made and seconded that each member would pay for their own lunch at the Annual Meeting with the club providing drinks. The motion passed.

A motion was made and seconded to accept the Treasurers Report, and it was passed unanimously.
